A250 Halfway Road, Minster-on-Sea
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER SEPTEMBER 2023

To allow resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A250 Halfway Road, Minster-on-Sea.

A closure is planned from 6th September 2023, with estimated completion by 12th September 2023, between the hours of 20.00 and 05.00, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE70558661175-02 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

A250 Halfway Road will be closed between Power Station Road and Danley Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while resurfacing works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A250 Queenborough Road, B2007 Main Road, A249 Brielle Way, A250 Bridge Road, Millennium Way, High Street and vice versa.
